1. RULES

1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board(s) located in the BYC Workshop.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.3. Signals made ashore will be displayed From the BYC flagpole.

7. RACING AREAS

Appendix B to this document shows the location of racing area.

8. THE COURSES

8.1. The diagram in *Appendix A to this document* shows the course. The order of marks shall be *Start – 1 – offset – 2 – 1 – offset – Finish.*

8.2. The approximate course length will be set with a target completion time of 1 hour.

8.3. If the Race Committee displays flag 'E' prior to the Warning for a race, boats will sail an extended course. The order of marks shall be *Start – 1 – offset – 2 – 1 – offset – 2 – 1 – offset - Finish.*

8.4. Marks 2P and 2S are a gate. Boats shall sail between the gate marks from the direction of the previous mark and round either gate mark.

9. Marks

9.1. Marks 1, 2p and 2S will be orange tetrahedrons.

9.2. The offset mark will be an orange ball.

9.3. A **new** mark will a yellow cylinder.

9.4. The ends of the start line will be bound by a red flag at the port end and orange triangle on the signal boat.

10. OBSTRUCTIONS

There are no obstructions

11. THE START

11.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange triangle on the starboard end signal boat and the course side of the port-end starting mark.

11.2. A boat that does not start within 10 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A4 and SSI 11.2.

12. CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

12.5 If one of the 'gate' marks (2s/2p) is missing the remaining one will be left to port.

13. THE FINISH

13.1 The finishing line will be between a the orange triangle on the signal boat at the port end staff displaying a red flag at the port end signal boat and the course side of the starboard-end finishing mark.

15. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

15.1. The race office is located in the BYC Clubhouse sailing school room.

15.3. The protest room is located in the BYC Clubhouse sailing school room.

20. EVENT ADVERTISING

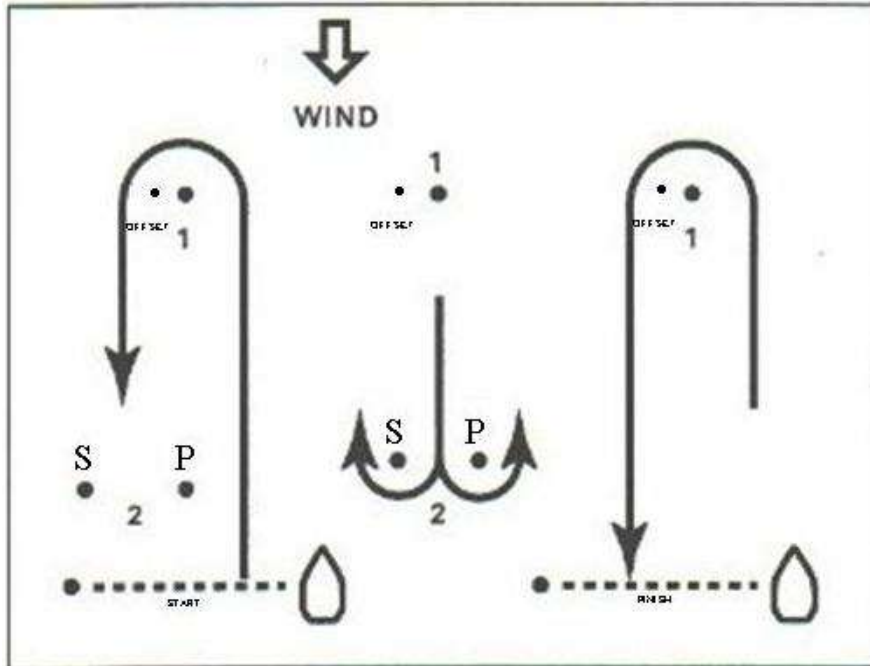
There is no event advertising.
